Cheryl started her Teamster career working in a warehouse where she actively assisted in an organizing campaign that successfully made her a proud union member. At the completion of their first contract Local Union 20 asked her to come to work for the Local as a clerk in their credit union. Her Teamster career in the years that followed flourished from that point to becoming the Treasurer of the Toledo Teamsters Federal Credit Union, Administrative Assistant to the President of Local 20, Ohio Conference of Teamsters State Coordinator, and she was appointed, and then elected, as a Trustee of the Local. In March of 1999, General President Hoffa appointed Cheryl as the Director of the Human Rights Commission. She was later given several additional appointments as Special Events Coordinator, President of the James R. Hoffa Memorial Scholarship Fund, Director of Community Services, Secretary to the Disaster Relief Fund, and Chairman of the International Teamsters Women's Committee. Lastly, Cheryl was sworn in as Central Region Vice-President on March 22, 2007.
